No. 640 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1974-19, APPROVED JUNE 19, 1974 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00) TO A CAPITAL FUND DESIGNATED "MERINO BRIDGE REPLACEMENT (3-25-00), ITEM 791-OTHER STRUCTURES & IMPROVEMENTS".

Approved December 20, 1974

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1974-19 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, as approved June 19, 1974 entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$85,823,307.71 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Period Beginning July 1, 1974 and Ending June 30, 1975" as amended is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) and transferring the same to a Capital Fund account designated as "Merino Bridge Replacement (3-25-00), Item 791 - Other Structures and Improvements".

SECTION 2. The said sum of One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures account to the Receipt account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures account are hereby increased by One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00).

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
