RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 287

Approved June 24, 1976

WHEREAS, Section 23-31 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, Approved October 21, 1968, and subsequently amended, entitled, "Use of Skateboards on Street, Highway, Sidewalk, Pedestrian Mall," prohibits any person from riding Skateboards on any Street, Highway, Sidewalk, or Pedestrian Mall within the limits of the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the use of such Skateboards as prohibited, is causing increasing hazards to both the users of said Boards and Pedestrians on Sidewalks and Drivers of Motor Vehicles on Highways in the City of Providence,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chief of the Police Department is urgently requested to cause the enforcement of the said Ordinance, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Provisions of Section 1-10, entitled, "General Penalty;" Continuing Violations, of the said Code, be Invoked.
