
This department received a memorandum and a copy of a petition for the abandonment of a portion of Sawyer Street, Providence, Rhode Island.



Portion of Sawyer Street

Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission, at its October 5, 1983 regular monthly meeting, reviewed and evaluated the subject referral.

A field inspection revealed that that portion of Sawyer Street from Stamford Avenue to its easterly terminus is partially paved, without sidewalks and curbs. Sawyer Street ends at Lot 146 and Lot 147, which are vacant and are part of a new subdivision of previous Lot 137, which has been subdivided into eleven (11) single family house lots. The street in question and its surrounding properties are within the R-1 single family zone. The majority of lots within the new subdivision contain new residential structures either under construction or already occupied. The only access to Lots 146 and 147 is provided from the extended eastern portion of Sawyer Street.

The matter of the abandonment of a portion of Sawyer Street was the subject of previous referrals No. 1939 and No. 2021. At that time, this Commission's recommendations were based upon the first subdivision of Lot 137 into thirteen (13) single family house lots where a new access street, Forestry Circle was outlined. Since then, a new subdivision took place and the eastern position of Sawyer St. became the only access to Lots 146 and 147.

The Commission

Voted: To advise the Committee on Public Works that that eastern portion of Sawyer Street should not be abandoned.


