NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in congratulating the Providence Journal Bulletin, as Recipient of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith "First Amendment Freedoms" Award, and John C.A. Watkins, its Chairman of the Board and Publisher, His Honor Mayor Vincent A. Cianci, Jr., and the Members of the City Council are mindful of the merit of the "First Amendment Freedoms" Award and the public service rendered by those most respected newspapers, and
