




On April 25, 1998 the Athenaeum will celebrate CARNEVALE DI VENEZIA. This will be an evening whose theme will be Venice, its art, culture and food. A large tent will be set up on Benefit Street for food (complements of local businesses and chefs), beverages, music and merriment. Mayor Cianci will, once again, be the honorary chairperson and assist in the auction. The celebration will extend into the Athenaeum building as well, but on a slightly more subdued level.

Prior to the event the Athenaeum will host a series of programs on Venetian art, architect, politics, and culture. In May and June four films "set in Venice" will be shown in the RISD auditorium.

Beginning March 19, 1998, Dale Chihuly will be exhibiting glass from his VENETIAN series at the Athenaeum. There will be a brunch for Dale on March 22 at 12 noon, with a lecture to follow at the RISD auditorium at 3:00 p.m.




