Dear Mayor Elorza:

The Fire Department respectfully requests to purchase a used 2011 Ford F-450 Rescue from: **Greenwood Emergency Vehicles, 530 John Dietsch Boulevard, North Attleboro, MA 02763.**

The Department is being offered the rescue through Greenwood Emergency Vehicles at a significantly lower cost than it would have been if the Department was to purchase the rescue new. The rescue, which is a trade in from a small volunteer fire department comes at a cost of **\$25,000**. A new rescue unit would cost the city of Providence a minimum of \$225,000 to \$250,000. Additionally, this unit includes a stretcher valued at \$3,000.

This vehicle will replace Rescue 14 which is a 2005 Ford with approximately 245,000 miles.
