

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 611

*Approved* October 19, 1997

WHEREAS, It has been brought to the attention of the City Council that the existing Public Safety Facility, located at LaSalle Square, is in need of major renovations and repairs, and

WHEREAS, It is the intention of the City Council to assess the feasibility of constructing a new Public Safety Facility, and

WHEREAS, An analysis of alternative site locations was conducted in 1992 through the Providence Public Building Authority, and

WHEREAS, It has been determined that the existing Public Safety site is a prime location for commercial development opportunities, and

WHEREAS, The City Council on June 19, 1997, passed a resolution in support of the development of a new Public Safety Building, and

WHEREAS, The Providence Redevelopment Agency has the expertise and experience to solicit development proposals and coordinate the development activities of the City of Providence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Providence Redevelopment Agency is hereby directed to solicit proposals for the development of a Public Safety Facility, consistent with the PBA analysis, which shall include proposals for an adaptive commercial use for the existing Public Safety site.
2. The Providence Redevelopment Agency shall submit all proposals for the development of a Public Safety Facility to the City Council Committee for Finance, and the Committee for Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning.
3. Upon submitting said proposals the Providence Redevelopment Agency shall present an analysis of the proposals as well as their recommendations.
4. The City Council Committee for Finance and the Committee for Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning shall, upon receipt of said proposals, report their findings to the full City Council for further action.

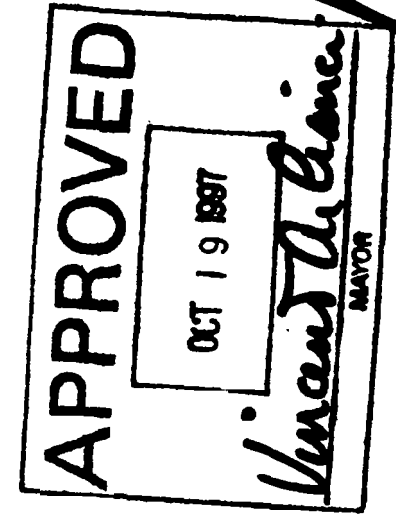

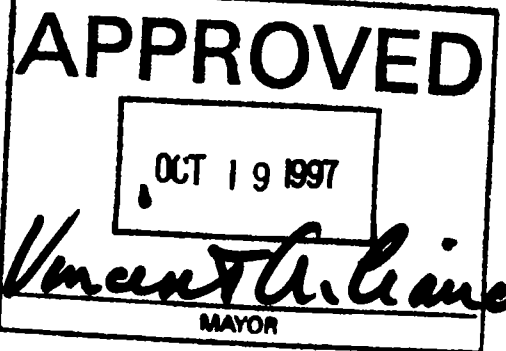
