## CHAPTER 1985-82

No. 540 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF AND, IN ADDITION TO SECTION 3, PARAGRAPH H, OF CHAPTER 1985-59, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PROTECTION, MAINTENANCE, REMOVAL AND PLANTING OF TREES IN THE PUBLIC STREETS, PARKS, OTHER PUBLIC PLACES, AND TREE PROTECTION ZONES ON DESIGNATED PRIVATE PROPERTY UNDER DEVELOPMENT, ESTABLISHING THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS AND ESTABLISHING THE DIVISION OF GROUNDS MAINTENANCE SERVICES, AS THE AGENCIES PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE PROTECTION, MAINTENANCE, REMOVAL, AND PLANTING OF TREES IN THE ABOVE MENTIONED PLACES, PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OR REMOVAL OF TREES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WHEN THE PUBLIC SAFETY IS ENDANGERED AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ITS PROVISIONS, AS AMENDED."

Approved October 9, 1985

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Section 3, paragraph H of Chapter 1985-59 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence is hereby amended by adding the following, after the word "city":

"but not to include property under the management and jurisdiction of the Water Supply Board."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its Passage.

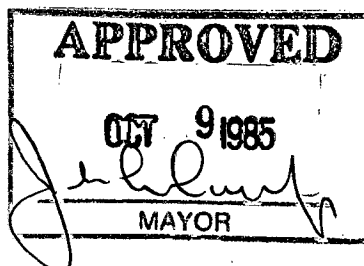

Dear Council Members:

We have received an Ordinance which regulates the protection, maintenance, removal, and planting of trees in public places and protection zones in the City of Providence.

We recognize and are in favor of the intent of the ordinance but make the following recommendations:

Under Section 3, Definitions, paragraph H, change to read:  
"Public place shall include any other ground owned by the city"  
but not to include property under the management and jurisdiction of the Water Supply Board.

Our watershed management operations are directed by professional foresters on our staff. We do not believe it should be the intent of this ordinance to place the Water Supply Board's management prerogatives under the Board of Park Commissioners and City Forester.

We thank you for your consideration in this matter.
