No. 3 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION; ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1983-30 APPROVED JULY 10, 1983, BY TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$29,500.00) FROM MOTOR FUEL ACCOUNT (1-005-17-02-11) TO MUNICIPAL DOCK (1-05-13-591) AS AMENDED.

**Be it ordained by the City of Providence:**

SECTION 1. Chapter 1983-30 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved July 10, 1983, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of One Hundred Sixty-Nine Million, Seven Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand, Two Hundred Forty Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$169,796,240.96) for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1983, as amended", is hereby further amended by transferring the sum of Twenty-Nine Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$29,500.00) from Motor Fuel Account (1-005-17-02-11) to Municipal Dock (1-05-13-591).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.



The Finance Department is requesting a transfer of \$29,500.00 within the 1983-1984 General Fund appropriation.
