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



WHEREAS, the members of this city council have noted with sincere regret the death on November 5, 1962 of John J. Regan, veteran former member of the city government, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Regan, son of the late John and Bridget (Early) Regan had an outstanding record of public service, having conscientiously served his native city for more than thirty-two years. He was elected to the Common Council from the old Third Ward in 1908 and served there until 1912 when he became a member of the Board of Aldermen in which he held office until January 6, 1919. At the 1920 Annual Meeting of the Freemen of the Town of Providence he was elected a commissioner of the Dexter Donation. His vast knowledge and experience in the real estate field was of inestimable value in the management of the Dexter properties. In 1941 when he respectfully declined re-election to the Board, he was publicly commended for his many years of faithful service and the efficient manner in which he executed his duties, and

WHEREAS, his long association in the business, civic, cultural and religious life of this community gained him a legion of friends who now mourn his passing.


