CONTAINED THEREIN FOR BOARD OF CANVASSERS, ITEMS 0, 1 and 2.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 886 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 17, 1954, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$30,448,534.47 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1955", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Ninety Four Hundred (\$9400) Dollars to the appropriation contained therein for BOARD OF CANVASSERS, ITEMS 0. 1 and 2. Said sum of Ninety Four Hundred (\$9400) Dollars shall be apportioned as follows: ITEM 0-\$7600; ITEM 1 - \$1400; ITEM 2 - \$400.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Ninety Four Hundred (\$9400) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Ninety Four Hundred (\$9400) Dollars.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height, and Area Regulations" is further amended by changing from a C-1 Limited Commercial Zone to a C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone, Lot 404 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 46; said lot being located at 792-798 Eddy Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of Eddy and Bay Streets; thence northerly along the easterly line of Eddy Street to the northwesterly corner of Lot 404 on Assessor's Plat 46; thence easterly along the southerly line of Lot 401 to the northeasterly corner of Lot 404; thence southerly along the easterly line of said Lot 404 to a jog; thence westerly along the northerly line of said Lot 404 to a second jog; thence again southerly along the easterly line of said Lot 404 to the northerly line of Bay Street and the southeasterly corner of said Lot 404; thence westerly along the said northerly line of Bay Street to the northeasterly corner of Eddy and Bay Streets and the point and place of beginning.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 707 - ZONING CHANGE AT 792-798 EDDY STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, May 24, 1955.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from a C-1 Zone to a C-4 Zone of Lot 404 on Assessor's Plat 46 located on the corner of Eddy and Bay Streets. The lot in question contains 7,395 square feet.

Inasmuch as there is a C-4 Zone directly across the street and to the southerly direction of the area in question, the granting of the petition will not substantially change the character of the immediate and surrounding neighborhood. Therefore,

VOTED: To offer no objection to the granting of the petition, provided the change includes only the area 100 feet from Eddy and from Bay Streets.
