# State of Rhode Island, &c.

## IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY

JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 19 74.

### AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A SURCHARGE ON ADMISSION TO EVENTS AT THE PROVIDENCE CIVIC CENTER.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. Definition of Terms- As used in this section.

- (a) The word "person" shall include, but shall not be limited to individuals, associations and corporations;
- (b) The word "admission" shall mean all charges established for admission, except those specifically designated as service charges;
- (c) The word "seller" shall mean a person required by this section to collect any surcharge imposed hereunder.

SEC. 2. Imposition of Surcharge.

There shall be levied and assessed a surcharge on admissions to any event held in the Providence Civic Center which will be at the rate of five cents (5¢) for each one hundred cents (100¢) or any fraction thereof of the admission. This surcharge shall be collected by the seller of any such admission at the time of the sale and shall be paid over in accordance with the following sections hereof.

SEC. 3. Records Required.

Every seller shall keep such books, including records, receipts, and other pertinent papers, in such form as the Providence Civic Center Authority may require.

SEC. 4. Surcharge Imposed as Additional to Other Charges.

Except as herein otherwise provided, the surcharge imposed by this section shall be in addition to any other charges imposed upon admissions.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
