AN ACT

IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 2721 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS, 1951.

RELATING TO THE BUREAU OF LICENSES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE.
It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 2721 of the Public Laws, 1951, entitled "An Act in Amendment of, and in addition to, Chapter 832 of the Public Laws, 1940, known as the "Providence Charter Act of 1940", as amended, creating a Bureau of Licenses in the City of Providence," is hereby amended by changing Sections 160 and 161 as added by said Section 1; of Chapter 2721 to read as follows:

"Sec. 160. The bureau of licenses shall consist of three members to be appointed by the Mayor with approval of the City Council, not more than two of whom shall be of the same political party. Appointments shall be made on the first Monday in January, 1955, or as soon thereafter as possible, and biennially thereafter. Members shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualified.

"Members of the bureau of licenses, excepting the commissioner of public safety, ex-officio, heretofore appointed to said bureau, shall continue in office until the expiration of their respective terms of office. As soon as possible after the passage of this act, the Mayor shall appoint, with the approval of the City Council, a member of said bureau in the place and stead of the commissioner of public safety. And upon the appointment and qualification of such member, the commissioner of public safety shall cease to be a member of the bureau.

"Sec. 161. One member of said bureau shall be designated by the Mayor as chairman and secretary thereof. The person designated as chairman and secretary shall be the executive officer of the bureau and shall be responsible for the issuance of all licenses granted by the bureau in accordance with law and ordinance. The members of said bureau shall receive such compensation as shall be fixed by the City Council."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
