WHEREAS, said bridge is no longer utilized for such travel.

WHEREAS, said bridge presents a hazard for navigation.

WHEREAS, the City in conjunction with the federal government is
planning the dismantling and removal of said bridge

WHEREAS, as part of that Agreement between the City of Providence and
the United States of America, title to said bridge shall be transferred to the Federal
Government.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor the Mayor is
authorized to transfer ownership of the India point Bridge to the United States of
America and further is authorized to negotiate conditions of the sale and to execute
any and all documents to effect such transfer.
