- 1) INCREASED POLICE PATROLS OF THAT AREA OF PLEASANT VALLEY PARKWAY PROXIMATE TO ACADEMY AVENUE (KNOWN LOCALLY AS THE UPPER PARKWAY)

The need for increased police patrols is occasioned by the recent use of the "Upper Parkway" as a "lover's lane" by various unidentified individuals. These persons interrupt the quiet of and enjoyment of property by the residents of the "Upper Parkway". In addition these individuals are prone to litter the area with such debris as cans and bottles of alcoholic beverages.

- 2) THE UTILIZATION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS OR ANY MONEYS SO DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PURPOSES OF FLOOD CONTROL OF THE "UPPER PARKWAY"

The need for flood control of the "Upper Parkway" is evidenced by the accumulation of water upon the property of various residents abutting the "Upper Parkway" during and after a prolonged or heavy rain. The depth of the stream running through the "Upper Parkway" is shallow, and there are no retaining walls to hold back water when conditions cause a rise in the water level. The water rises onto the surrounding grassy area causing constant erosion of soil and eventually rises onto the abutting streets and private property causing inconvenience, hazardous conditions, and property damage.
