NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the recommendation of this City Council that the Committee on Naming of Buildings, Expressways, Bridges, Edifices and Other City Construction, change the name of Regent Avenue Elementary School, located at 101 Regent Avenue to "Francis Crowley Memorial School."
