It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 37-8 of the General Laws entitled "Public Buildings" is hereby  
2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3           37-8-3.1. The State of Rhode Island and the City of Providence shall be jointly  
4 responsible for operation and maintenance of the hurricane barrier in the Fox Point section  
5 of the City of Providence. -- The state shall reimburse the city of Providence for fifty percent  
6 (50%) of any and all qualified expenditures on the hurricane barrier. "Qualified expenditures"  
7 shall include all reasonable and necessary amounts spent on personnel, repairs, maintenance and  
8 capital improvements to the hurricane barrier facility. The city of Providence shall document  
9 any and all qualified expenditures on the hurricane barrier by providing a verified summary of  
10 cost incurred in any given fiscal year signed by the finance director and supported by copies of  
11 invoices of expenditures. Personnel costs shall be documented on an hourly basis per employee.  
12 The city shall certify the qualified expenditures by June 30 of each fiscal year. The state shall be  
13 required to make said payment annually on July 30 and the city shall be able to include said  
14 payment in the preceding fiscal year.

15           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
