CHAPTER 1984-71

No. 573 **AN ORDINANCE** IMPOSING THE ADDITIONAL CHARGE FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COURT COSTS IN THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES OR FEES DUE THE CITY.

Approved October 23, 1984

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Any person (as defined in section 44-7-1 of Rhode Island General Laws) who is delinquent for more than thirty (30) days in the payment of any tax, fee, or assessment of whatever nature due and payable to the City of Providence, Rhode Island shall be liable for the assessment and payment of reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs incurred by the City in the collection of the said delinquent taxes, fees or assessments.

SECTION 2. The said attorneys' fees and court costs shall be assessed in addition to any other penalty or charge allowed by law, including but not limited to legal interest.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be in addition to and not in lieu of or in derogation of any authority or power provided to the City or the City Collector under existing laws or ordinances.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

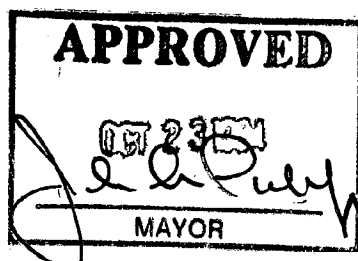
