No. 120 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", AS AMENDED.

Approved March 16, 1990

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, entitled "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following

Article VIII. Reasonable Speeds.

Section 15-108. Reasonable and prudent speeds.

No person shall drive a vehicle on a highway at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions and having regard to the actual and potential hazards then existing in every event, speed shall be so controlled as may be necessary to avoid colliding with any person, vehicle, or other conveyance on or entering the highway in compliance with legal requirements and the duty of all persons to use due care.

Section 15-109. Conditions requiring reduced speed.

The driver of every vehicle shall, consistent with the requirements of Section 15-108 drive at an appropriate reduced speed when approaching and crossing an intersection or railroad grade crossing, when approaching and going around a curve, when approaching a hill crest, when traveling upon any narrow or winding roadway and when special hazard exists with respect to pedestrians or other traffic or by reason of weather or highway conditions.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

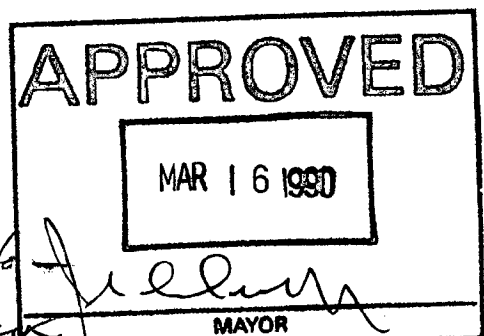
