RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 411

Approved August 6, 1976

WHEREAS, certain residents within the Seventh Ward of Providence have complained to Councilman Louis R. Stravato that they are experiencing physical discomfort, which is injurious to their health, peace and comfort as a result of what they contend, is unnecessary loud sounds from electronic devices, such as radios and televisions, in certain residences in that area, and

WHEREAS, these same persons have alleged that complaints to the Police Department has brought no relief, apparently from non-investigations of these alleged complaints,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chief of the Police Department, admonish the Members of that Department to enforce the Provisions of Section 16-10, Entitled, "Noise - Prohibited Generally", particularly when they are cruising in the said area and are attracted by such noise, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of the Police Department cause the said Section, incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, read at each Roll Call of the Members of the Police Department, at least once, upon receipt of a duly certified copy of this Resolution, from the City Clerk.
