

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 28

Approved January 21, 1980

WHEREAS, Doctor Frank J. Honan, family physician, has elected to retire, having completed forty-nine years and eight months of dedicated service to his profession, and

WHEREAS, During his nearly half century of practicing medicine which began on April 1, 1930, he remained in the neighborhood of his birth, in which his children were born and reared, and

WHEREAS, Always available, whether called upon day or night, to his legions of patients, he became renown in the City of Providence, and its surrounding areas, and

WHEREAS, Loved and respected by his many patients, some of whom had moved to outlying cities and towns and still, faithfully, returned to seek his services, and

WHEREAS, A patriach in the delivery of infants, he has brought more than five thousand infants into this world, approximately one-third being home deliveries, and

WHEREAS, Concerned with his patients finances, Doctor Honan's fees were, by far, moderate, being inconsistent with the rising costs throughout the country, and

WHEREAS, Ever cognizant of his patients' needs, he remained one of the few physicians who responded to "House Calls, his last visit being made on November 28, 1979,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of this City Council, knowledgeable of the dignity and credibility Doctor Frank J. Honan has given to the medical profession, hereby offer their sincere congratulations upon his retirement and wish him, good health and enjoyment in his future years.
