

WHEREAS, The City of Providence Parks Department shall hold its Annual International Arts Festival entitled "Convergence VIII", and

WHEREAS, As part of that celebration the Department would like to install two (2) steel sculptures on the sidewalk located adjacent to 95-120 Empire Street, and

WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Public Works has found that the proposed sculptures would not unreasonably interfere in the free passage of pedestrian traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City of Providence Parks Department may temporarily install two (2) steel sculptures on the sidewalk located adjacent to 95-120 Empire Street provided that said installation shall conform to the description of the same given to the Council Committee on Public Works and that the Parks Department obtain insurance protecting the City of Providence, its agents, officers, servants and employees from any and all claims arising out of the placement, installation and maintenance of said sculptures and upon such other conditions as the City Solicitor and His Honor, the Mayor, may impose.

Dear Chairman Clarkin and Committee Members,

In celebration of the Providence Parks Department, Division of Public Programming's Twentieth Anniversary, the Department requests a sidewalk permit for 95-120 Empire Street. We would like to temporarily install two welded steel sculptures between the street tree wells for a period of time not to exceed two months beginning April 1, 1995.
