RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to prohibit motor vehicle traffic along Pine Street to one lane from Dorrance Street to Page Street on Friday, September 6, 2002 and Saturday, September 7, 2002 between the hours of 6:00 o'clock a.m. to 6:00 o'clock p.m., and that Page Street be closed entirely to outside traffic and will also require traffic detail along Weybosset, Pine, and Claverick Streets to accommodate the influx of students for the beginning of the school year for Johnson and Wales University.



We want our students' first introduction to the City of Providence to be a positive one. The moving in process has always gone smoothly with your assistance, and we would like to continue with that tradition again this year.
