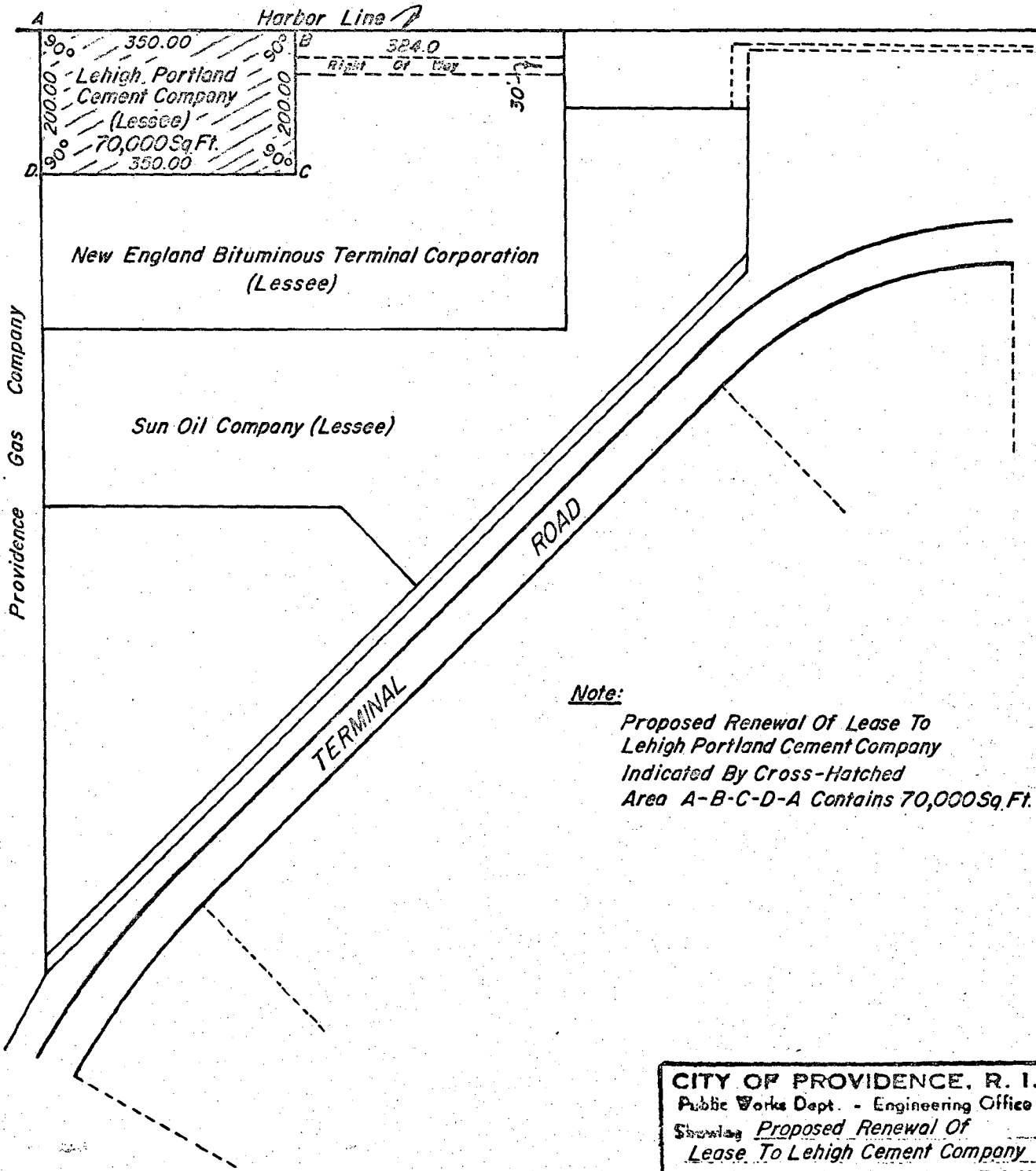


On June 8 in response to a memorandum relating to the abandonment of a portion of Mason Street we requested that the customary plan showing the abutting owners be submitted.

This request was made to assess the effect on our facilities to adequately and legally supply water for fire protection and general use. To date we have not received the plat plan.

We wish to advise the committee in view of the pending resolution that the water main in subject portion of Mason Street provides the water supply to #28 Mason Street, a private fire supply to #27 Sabin Street and public fire protection from a hydrant.

It has not been the policy of the Water Supply Board to furnish these types of service from a distribution main located in a easement. Therefore, we respectfully recommend that the petition for the abandonment of the referenced portion of Mason Street under the proposed conditions be denied.

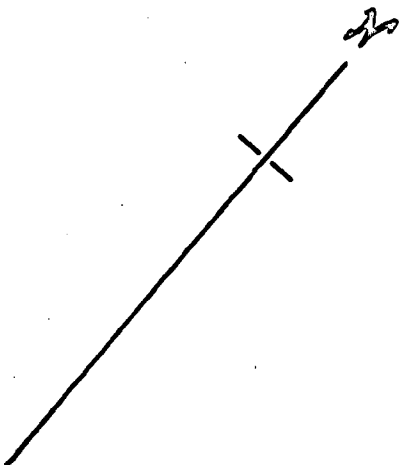
