**RE:** PENDING MATTER

**REQUEST:** That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of a permanent traffic signal light at the intersection of Laurel Hill Avenue and Plainfield Street.

**DISPOSITON:** This intersection does warrant a traffic signal, however funds are not available at this time. It is estimated that design and construction costs would probably exceed \$60,000.00. Bond monies could be used if Councilman Iglioizzi approves the allocation.
