Dear Mrs. Mendonca:

Enclosed are two (2) forms of Resolution of the City Council and three (3) copies of each, prepared by this Department authorizing the Board of Contract and Supply to purchase on behalf of the City of Providence unsold parcels located in the Model Cities and Lippitt Hill Urban Renewal Projects. The land to be sold to the City consists of land previously acquired by the Providence Redevelopment Agency that has remained unsold.

The Model Cities and Lippitt Hill Projects were financed in part by the Federal Government, and under terms of our contract with the United States Department of Planning and Urban Development, the City is obligated to acquire all unsold land. All attempts by the Providence Redevelopment Agency to dispose of this land by sale have been unsuccessful.
