WHEREAS, The Police Department, Roger Williams Park and the Public Works Department recycle,

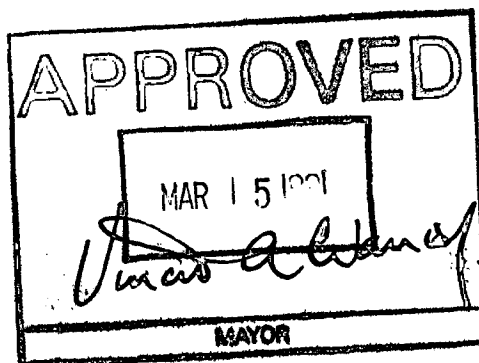

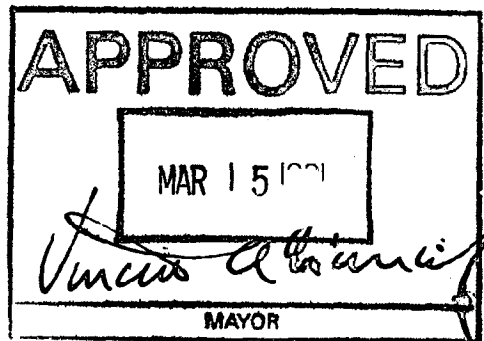
WHEREAS, "War is hell" were the words once spoken and that is a truth the military force does face, and did so with honor and valor,
