CHAPTER 149

No. 554 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2 OF CHAPTER 18 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, 1946, REQUIRING ADVERTISING OF APPLICATIONS TO KEEP JUNK SHOPS, OLD METALS AND OTHER SECOND HAND ARTICLES.

Approved September 20, 1957

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 2. License application.

- A. Every applicant for a license as required by section 1 hereof shall set forth, with full particulars, upon a form to be furnished by the Bureau of Licenses, answers to the following questions:

First: Name and address, both of residence and of business of the applicant?

Second: Business or employment of the applicant, during the five years next preceding application?

Third: Age of the applicant?

Such application shall be referred to the chief of police for his approval or disapproval, before being acted upon by the Bureau of Licenses.

- B. Notice of an application to keep a junk shop, storehouse for the reception of any junk, old metals or other secondhand articles in any location not occupied for such purposes at the time of the filing of the application for such license shall be given by publication at least twice in a daily newspaper published in the City of Providence. Said notice shall set forth the name of the applicant, the location of the premises sought to be licensed, the time and place of the hearing and the right to remonstrate against the granting of the application. The first publication shall be published not less than ten days prior to the hearing.

- C. Applications for the renewal or transfer of such licenses shall not be advertised.

CHAPTER 1150

No. 555 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 544 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 21, 1951, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, IS HEREBY FURTHER AMENDED BY CHANGING FROM AN R-4 MULTIPLE DWELLING ZONE TO A C-4 HEAVY COMMERCIAL ZONE, LOT 322 AS SET OUT AND DELINEATED ON CITY ASSESSOR'S PLAT 29; SAID LOT BEING LOCATED ON THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF HAYWARD AND SOMERSET STREETS AND BEING DESIGNATED AS 9-11 SOMERSET STREET.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations" is hereby further amended by changing from an R-4 Multiple Dwelling Zone to a C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone, Lot 322 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 29; said lot being located on the southwesterly corner of Hayward and Somerset Streets and being designated as 9-11 Somerset Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the southwesterly corner of Hayward and Somerset Streets at the northeasterly corner of Lot 322 on Assessor's Plat 29; thence southerly along the westerly line of Hayward Street to the southeasterly corner of Lot 322; thence northerly along a line one hundred (100) feet from and parallel with the easterly line of Broad Street to the southerly line of Somerset Street; thence easterly along the said southerly line of Somerset Street to the southwesterly corner of Hayward and Somerset Streets and the point and place of beginning.

Sec. 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

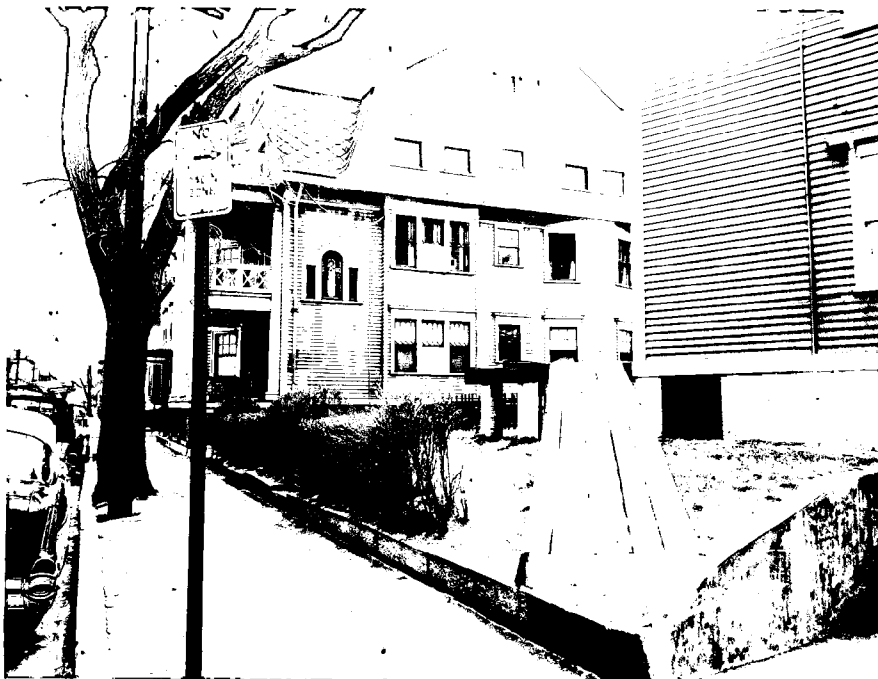

BROAD CT



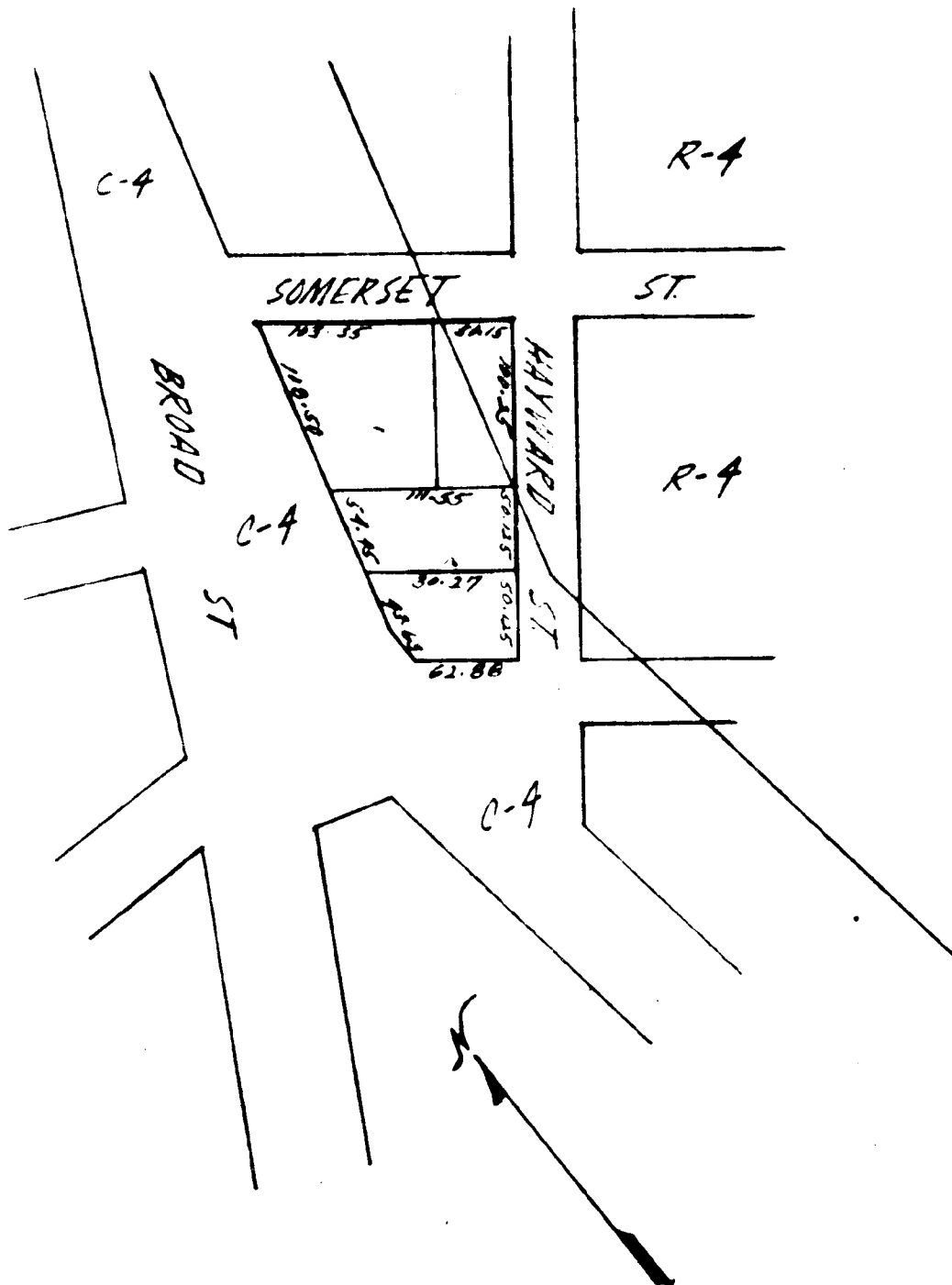
SOMERSET ST.

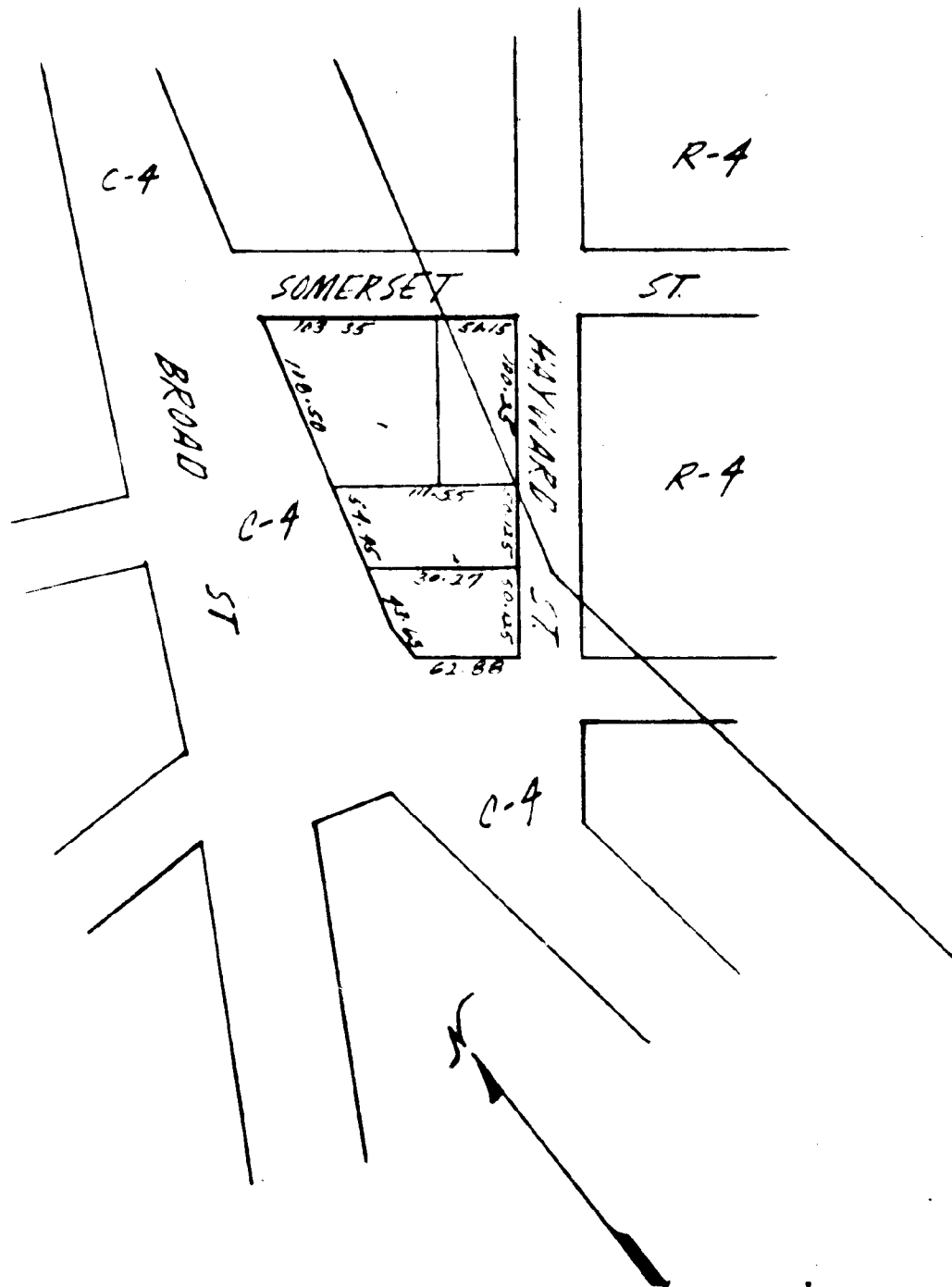

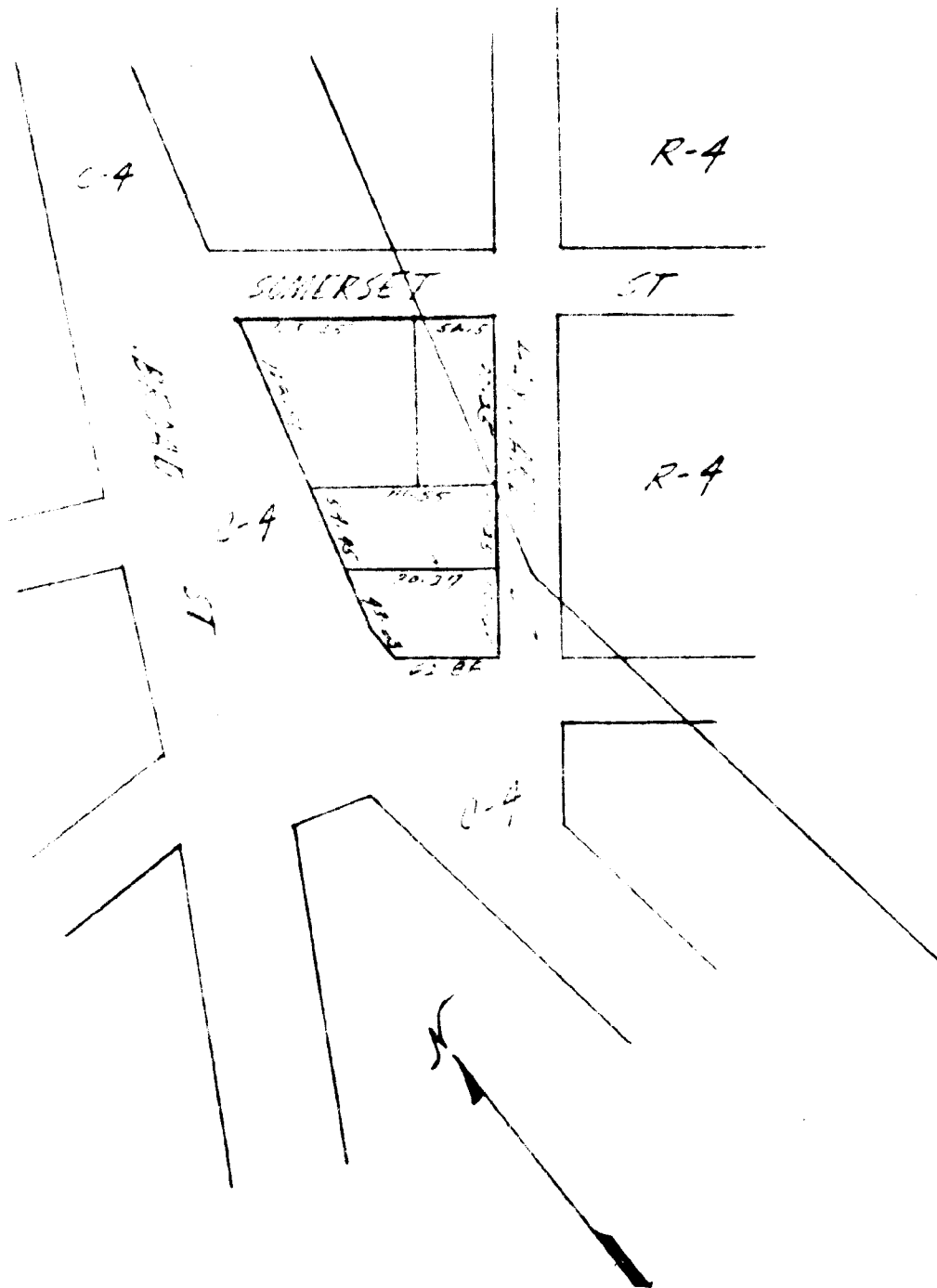

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, July 9, 1957.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from an R-4 Zone to a C-4 Zone of Lot 322 on Assessor's Plat 29 located at 9-11 Somerset Street.

Reference is made to Referral No. 812, dated May 21, 1956, from the Committee on Ordinances at which time it was requested that the R-4 Zone be changed to a C-4 Zone. The City Plan Commission offered no objection to the granting of this petition, however, the City Council denied the request on June 6, 1956.

On the field trip it was found that the area in question is at present occupied by a three-family dwelling and a two-car garage.

VOTED: To offer no objection to the granting of this petition.

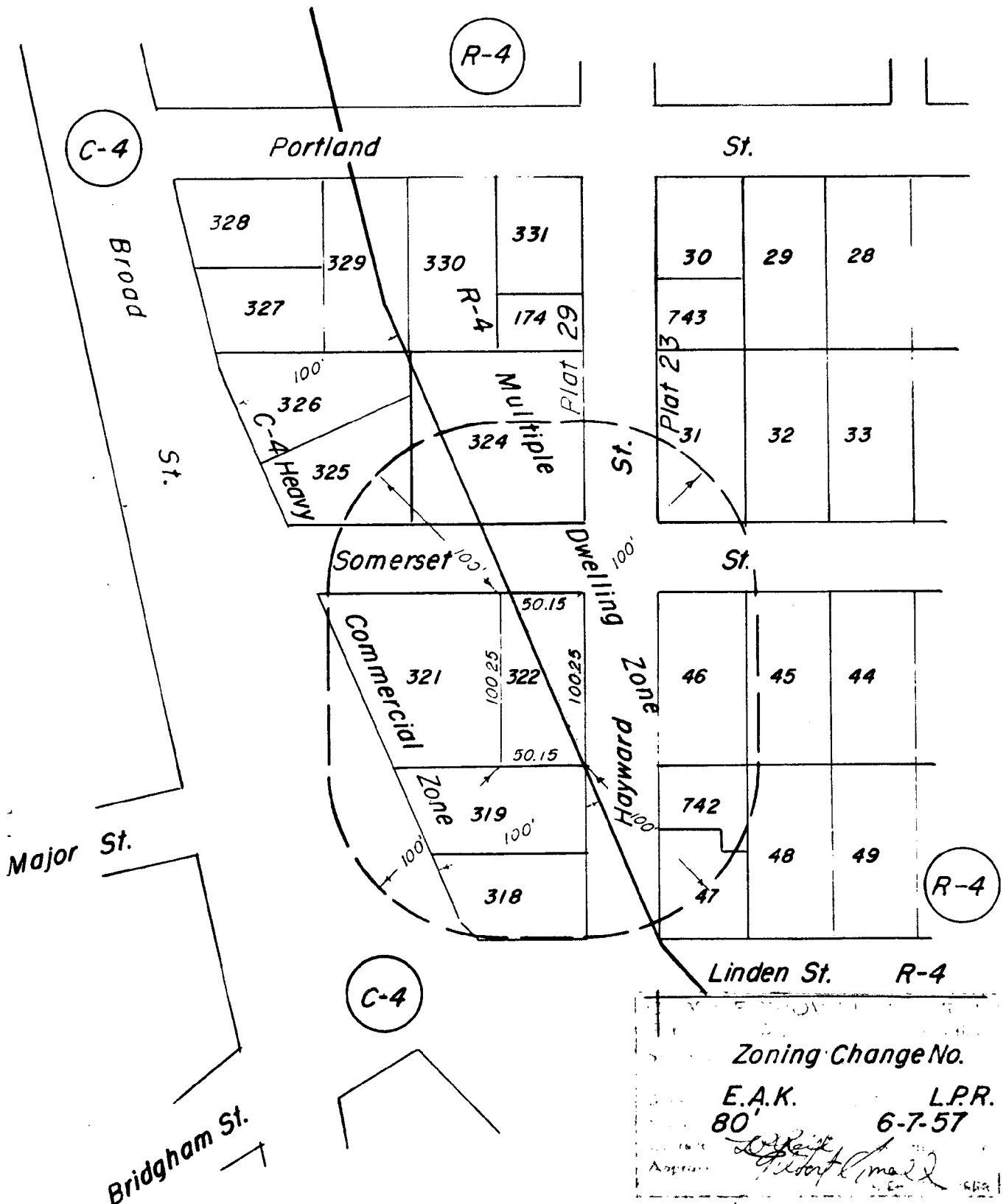
