RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION (S) UNDER THE URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT OF 1964 (P.L. 88-365), AS AMENDED -- (SECTION 3)

WHEREAS, the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964 (P.L. 88-365), as amended, authorizes the Secretary of Transportation to make grants or loans to assist local public bodies and agencies thereof in financing the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, and improvement of facilities and equipment for use in mass transportation service in urban areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Providence deems it necessary and in the public interest (1) to undertake specific projects within the definition of mass transportation service in urban areas and (2) to cooperate with the Rhode Island Public Transit Authority in providing for an efficient and coordinated mass transportation system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Providence, in order to obtain such grants must assure and certify that it shall comply with all the regulations, policies, guidelines and requirements for the acceptance and use of federal funds including the provision of the local share of project costs and gives assurance and certifies it will comply in particular with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder and other assurances as required under application procedures of the U.S. Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE as follows:

1. That the Mayor of the City of Providence is hereby authorized and designated as the representative of the City for the filing of application(s) with the U.S. Department of Transportation, to aid in the financing of the Kennedy Plaza Transit and Pedestrian
