Dear Members:

Under authority granted to me by Chapter 3, Section 3.18 of the Charter of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, I hereby disapprove and veto the Resolution of the City Council of Providence that requests the Providence Redevelopment Agency refrain from selling any of its real estate to a prospective buyer who has not corrected or otherwise removed any violations or charges still pending against him under the Minimum Housing Code. I take this action because this resolution not only is highly restrictive of bidders, but also because it is patently unconstitutional in that it is vague, indefinite, and highly proscriptive.
