# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved

WHEREAS, Governor Philip W. Noel, in a recent interview, was quoted as having made certain derogatory references of the moral conduct of Black Citizens having residency in Ghettos, so-called, and

WHEREAS, his offensive and unfounded remarks have had a most unsavory effect upon all Black Citizens in the State of Rhode Island, in view of his candidacy for the Permanent Chairmanship of the Democratic National Platform Committee, and

WHEREAS, these same Citizens, whose progenitors, under the most adverse of social conditions, have, history of the United States of America records, contributed much to the greatness of our Nation, thus refuting unequivocally, his allegations,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this City Council hereby petitions Governor Philip W. Noel to resign, forthwith, as Temporary Chairman of the Democratic National Platform Committee and to further refrain from seeking the Permanent Chairmanship of the said Committee, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to cause a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution to be transmitted to the Office of the Governor in the State Capitol, Providence.
