No. **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1143 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$75,000.00) DOLLARS FOR PENSION PAYMENTS.

Approved

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Chapter 1143 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 20, 1957 entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$36,161,545.40 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1958" is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$75,000.00) DOLLARS for the payment of annuities to unmarried widows of policemen and firemen who have died while in service or were retired from active duty on pension prior to death.

Sec. 2. The annuities shall be at the rate of Twelve Hundred (\$1,200.00) Dollars per year and shall be payable under the supervision and administration of the Finance Committee of the City Council.

Sec. 3. Said sum of Seventy-Five Thousand (\$75,000.00) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extra-ordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

Sec. 4. The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extra-ordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Seventy-Five Thousand (\$75,000.00) Dollars.

Sec. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 956 - ZONING CHANGE OF LOTS ON NARRAGANSETT
AVENUE, ARDOENE STREET AND WOODMONT
STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, January 14, 1958.

This referral is a request for a change of zoning from an R-2 Zone to a C-2 Zone Lots 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61 and 62 on Assessor's Plat 125 located in the vicinity of Narragansett Avenue, Ardoene Street and Woodmont Street. The area in question contains 31,911 square feet.


On the field trip it was found that the area in question is vacant land.

The granting of this petition would create a commercial use in a residential zone creating a new case of spot zoning which would adversely affect the adjoining and surrounding residential properties. Also, this area is in a proposed new playground site, acquisition of which has been initiated by the City Council. Therefore,
