# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved December 22, 1982

WHEREAS, Timothy J. Ahern, late Retired Member of the City Council from the Twelfth Ward of the City of Providence, Rhode Island from 1968 to 1978, has passed from this Life on the 15th Day of December, 1982 and

WHEREAS, During most of his adult life, he was employed by Brown & Sharpe Manufacturing Company until his retirement, and

WHEREAS, He served his Country during World War II in the United States Army, following which he became an active Member in Civic and Religious Organizations, and

WHEREAS, During his tenure as a Member of the City Council, "Tim" Ahern served on several Committees of the City Council; namely, the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning, the Committee on Ordinances, as Vice-Chairman of the Committee on Public Welfare, and as Chairman of Dr. Charles V. Chapin Memorial Award Committee, and

WHEREAS, His serene manner and exemplary conduct earned him the respect of his colleagues and forever endeared him to the people of the Twelfth Ward,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That in the untimely passing of Timothy J. Ahern, the Members of the City Council express to his bereaved wife, Hope, their sons, Robert J. and Brian T., and their daughter Patricia L. Campbell, their profound sympathy in the great loss they have sustained, and
