

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 215

Approved April 15, 1977

WHEREAS, Vincent Vespia, City Clerk of Providence, Rhode Island, is scheduled to mandatorily retire September 1, 1977, from that position with the City Government, and

WHEREAS, as a gesture of esteem and note of his Thirty-Six Years in the Department of City Clerk, as Second and First Deputies and as City Clerk, the City Council of Providence is of the opinion that tangible evidence of his service, as its Clerk, be awarded to him,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the General Assembly is requested to direct the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to issue Special Registration Plates for the private motor vehicle of Vincent Vespia, City Clerk of Providence, Rhode Island; said plates to bear the identification "Providence City Clerk Emeritus", the same shall be furnished without additional registration fee, for such period of time as he desires.
