# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 867

Approved November 27, 1975

WHEREAS, the intersection of North Main Street, Cypress Street and Branch Avenue, was designated, by the former Board of Aldermen, on September 1, 1932, as "Charles H. Byrne Memorial Square," and

WHEREAS, as a result of certain highway improvements in that area, the Plaque so designating that fact and Pole, was removed and was not replaced, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development, charged with the supervision of the said improvements, is requested to cause the replacement of that missing Plaque and Pole, designating the intersection of North Main Street, Cypress Street, and Branch Avenue as, "Charles H. Byrne Memorial Square."


RE: City Council Resolution No. 867, approved Nov. 27, 1975
