Approved August 15, 1981

RESOLVED, That the accompanying plat, entitled dedication for Right-of-Way (Trinity Mews), Weybosset Hill Project, R.I. R-7, Providence Redevelopment Agency, Stanley P. Blacher, Chairman, et al scale 1' = 40.0' dedicating for pedestrian purpose a certain tract or parcel of land situated between Washington Street and Fountain Street shown as a cross-hatched area and designated by the letters A-B-C-D-A on the accompanying plan under the provisions of Chapter 987 of the Public Laws of 1913 and thereafter declared a public right-of-way to be repaired and maintained at the expense of the City of Providence.

Dedication for Right-of-Way  
Weybosset Hill Project R.I. R-7  
Assessors Plat 25 Lot 179

That certain tract or parcel of land with all buildings and improvements thereon situated on the southeasterly side of Fountain Street, northeasterly side of Aborn Street and northwesterly side of Washington Street in the City of Providence, County of Providence, and State of Rhode Island being bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the southeasterly side of Fountain Street and the northeasterly side of Aborn Street.

Thence running northeasterly, bounded northwesterly by said Fountain Street, a distance of fifty six and  $32/100$  (56.32) feet to a corner and other land belonging to the Providence Redevelopment Agency;

Thence turning an interior angle of  $84^{\circ}-26'-59''$  and running southeasterly, bounded northeasterly by said Providence Redevelopment Agency land, a distance of two hundred eleven and  $52/100$  (211.52) feet to Washington Street;

Thence turning an interior angle of  $89^{\circ}-17'-11''$  and running southwesterly, bounded southeasterly by said Washington Street, a distance of three and  $47/100$  (3.47) feet to said Aborn Street;

Thence turning an interior angle of  $105^{\circ}-01'-50''$  and running northwesterly, bounded southwesterly by said Aborn Street, a distance of two hundred twelve and  $63/100$  (212.63) feet to said Fountain Street and the point of beginning. The first and last described courses form an interior angle of  $81^{\circ}-14'-00''$ .

Said parcel contains 6,285 square feet of land.
