RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 476

Approved July 15, 1983

WHEREAS, The Capital Center Project is of the highest importance to the economic development of the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, An important reason for the Project's success to date has been the willingness of the City, the State of Rhode Island and the private sector to work cooperatively on this venture, and

WHEREAS, The State and City legislation establishing the Capital Center Commission provides for an equitable proportion of members appointed by the Mayor, the Governor, the Providence Foundation as well as representatives of the General Assembly and the City Council, and

WHEREAS, It is in the public interest that this balance be retained so as to foster the cooperation that is so essential to the success of the Capital Center Project, and

WHEREAS, The General Assembly passed an Act which adds three additional members to the Commission who are to be appointed by State Officials, and which will thereby create an undesirable imbalance in the proportion of members from the various parties,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council President inform the Speaker of the Rhode Island House of Representatives and the Majority Leader of the Senate that the City Council requests these two legislators not to exercise their authority, granted under the Act, to make one appointment each to the commission; and that the President inform the Governor of Rhode Island that the Council requests he not exercise his authority, granted under the Act, to make his fifth appointment to the Commission.
