RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 118

Approved February 28, 1999

WHEREAS, An Ordinance appropriating \$50 million and authorizing the issuance of \$50 million in bonds for the Neighborhood Improvement Program: A Plan to Revitalize Providence's Neighborhood's was adopted (1997-27); and;

WHEREAS, said ordinance requires that "each component of said plan will be developed and approved by the City Council prior to the expenditures of any funds", and;

WHEREAS, \$27,893,085.00 million has been appropriated by Council Resolution No. 375 dated June 30, 1997 as well as Council Resolution Numbers 474 dated August 22, 1997, 610 dated October 19, 1997, 702 & 703 dated December 19, 1997, 163 dated March 16, 1998, 258 & 259 dated April 24, 1998, 357 dated June 26, 1998, 555 dated September 28, 1998 and No. 719 dated December 28, 1998 for various projects; and;

WHEREAS, plans have been developed for additional components of the Neighborhood Improvement Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following expenditures of funds are approved:

1. NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS:

A. Ward 2

1. Blackstone Boulevard Park Project (additional funds) - \$50,000.00

B. Ward 7

1. Springfield Street Reconstruction Project - \$25,000.00
2. Elimination of Blight Program Fund (additional Funds) - \$25,000.00
3. Neutaconkanut Park Improvements (additional funds) - \$25,000.00

C. Ward 11

1. Property acquisition, Mrytle, Dudley, Friendship & Clifford Streets (additional funds) - \$25,000.00
2. Oasis Credit Union - \$3,000.00
3. 242-244 Broad Street Rehabilitation - \$17,140.00
4. Home Repair Assistance Program - \$100,000.00

D. Ward 9

1. 187 Lenox Avenue Rehabilitation - \$4,455.00
2. CityArts (Traffic Calming) - \$1,779.80
3. Micro-Loan Program - \$50,000.00
