Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has investigated the request for time limited parking on Whitmarsh Street between Dexter Street and Elmwood Avenue.

Repeated observations of the amount of parking taking place on this street indicates an average parking demand of 8 to 12 spaces at the Bucklin Street end of the block. The remaining 12 spaces to Elmwood Avenue are available almost constantly. In view of this very limited demand for parking it is felt that no parking time limits are required at this time.


Dear Jack:

In reply to your request for my opinion of the desirability of condemning for highway purposes the property on Lot 286 on Assessor's Plat 28, I can see no appreciable benefit to be derived by using this property for highway purposes.

If this property were vacant City land, then it might be desirable to extend Ringgold Street across Kenyon Street to Federal Street and install some intersection channelization within the rest of the intersection of Federal, Kenyon, and Dean Streets.

However, the cost of demolishing the present structures and acquiring the property is greatly out of balance with the benefit to be derived from such a change.


