WHEREAS, Arthur M. Zarrella, Principal of Central High School, City of Providence, Rhode Island has been in the educational field for some twenty-two years, and

WHEREAS, Arthur M. Zarrella began teaching at Central High in 1968 as a Social Studies Teacher, and, thus after a brief period at the school was elevated to the rank as head of the school's Social Studies Department, and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 1972 he was again rewarded for his performance by being appointed as acting Student Relations Administrator of the Providence School Department and soon after as its full time director, and

WHEREAS, by continually showing his leadership and administrative abilities, he again was elevated to an even higher rank in the system, this time as the Principal of Central High School on September 1, 1976,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in noting the various achievements of Arthur M. Zarrella and that under his stewardship at Central High School, the school has been recognized by many foundations as a role model school, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council takes pride in his stewardship and expresses its appreciation for his continued service for the betterment of the Faculty and Students he serves.

SUBJECT: PROPOSAL FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW BRIDGE OVER THE CHICAGO RIVER

Enclosed for the City Council are two copies of a report and a copy of a resolution regarding the proposed construction of a new bridge over the Chicago River. The report, dated December 15, 1983, contains a detailed description of the project, including the location, design, and estimated cost. The resolution, dated December 15, 1983, recommends that the City Council approve the project and authorize the City Engineer to execute the necessary contracts.

The project is a major infrastructure improvement that will provide a new and more efficient means of crossing the Chicago River. It is estimated that the project will cost approximately \$10 million and will be completed within 18 months. The new bridge will be a steel truss bridge, which is a more durable and efficient design than the existing bridge. It will also be wider and taller, allowing for the passage of larger boats and trucks.

The project is a high priority for the City of Chicago, as it will improve the city's transportation infrastructure and provide a new and more efficient means of crossing the Chicago River. It is recommended that the City Council approve the project and authorize the City Engineer to execute the necessary contracts.
