

**RADIO ENGINEER**

**CLASS TITLE:** Radio Engineer

**CLASS DEFINITION:** Responsible supervision of the maintenance and repair of a radio communication system.

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:** Work involves responsibility for servicing and maintaining a radio communication system; repairing a radio station and mobile units; maintaining control units. Repairs and maintains a public address system and recording units. Removes and installs radio receiving equipment in vehicles. Repairs and maintains radio antenna and masts. Prepares plans and specifications of required departmental radio equipment. Measures frequency of radio station to ensure compliance with operating requirements. Maintains records pertaining to radio operation.

**DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:** Thorough knowledge of radio equipment. Considerable knowledge of the operating principles of complex electrical equipment. Considerable knowledge of the methods, tools, equipment and materials used in radio testing, construction, repair and maintenance. Considerable knowledge of pertinent Federal Communications Commission rules and regulations governing the transmission and reception of messages by radio equipment. Working knowledge of current improvements and developments in radio systems, including equipment and techniques. Skill in the use and care of the tools and equipment used in the work.

**QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR APPOINTMENT:** Graduation from a standard high school or trade school, including or supplemented with technical training in radio and electrical theory. Considerable experience in short wave radio-telephone operations, including installation, maintenance and repair.

**SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:** Possession of a First Class or Second Class Radio-Telephone Operator's License as issued by the Federal Communications Commission.
