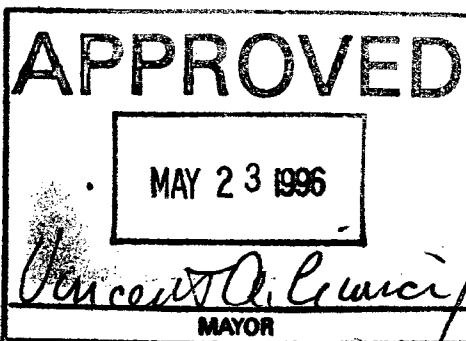

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REQUEST: THAT THE TRAFFIC ENGINEER ESTABLISH THE INTERSECTION  
OF TABER AVENUE AND IRVING AVENUE AS A FOUR WAY  
STOP CONTROL.

DISPOSITION: WITH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FOUR-WAY STOP CONTROL  
AT TABER AND HUMBOLDT AVENUES, THIS DEPARTMENT
