RESOLVED, That South Water Street, from Tockwotton Street to Bridge Street, be established as a One-Way Street in a northerly direction.

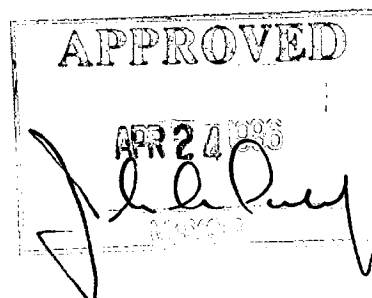

RE: ONE WAY STREET - CORLISS LANDING
FOR: Transmittal to Committee on Public Works

In order to improve vehicular circulation in the very congested Corliss Landing area and to provide for more on-street parking as part of the Corliss Landing Development Project, I hereby recommend the following streets be established as one-way:

Tockwotton Street, one way westerly, between South Main Street and South Water Street.

South Water Street, one way northerly, between Tockwotton Street and Bridge Street.

(Note that as shown on the attached plan, South Main Street is already on-way between Bridge Street and Tockwotton Street).
