CHAPTER 1994-56

No. 802 **AN ORDINANCE** REGULATING THE REMOVAL OF SNOW IN
THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, AS AMENDED.

Approved December 27, 1994

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. All owners of any building or lot bordering upon any street, highway or public place within the City shall within the first four (4) hours of daylight after the end of any snowfall, or the deposit of snow on the sidewalk of said building or lot from any cause whatever:

- (a) Remove or cause to be removed all snow from a path not less than three (3) feet in width of the entire border in or on said street, highway, or public place;
- (b) Remove or cause to be removed all snow from around any fire hydrant on the sidewalk in front of said building or lot;
- (c) Remove or cause to be removed all snow from the opening of any catch basin in the sidewalk of said building or lot;
- (d) Remove or cause to be removed all snow from pedestrian-access ramps cut into street curbs bordering said building or lot;

Any person found guilty of violating this Section shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$300.00.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
