

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, July 22, 1958.


This referral is a request to review for acceptance Woodland Terrace for highway purposes.



The subject referrals received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, June 10, 1958.

These referrals are requests for the abandonment as public highways Grand Street, Seabury Street, Halton Street and Chambers Street starting at a point south of Huntington Avenue to the land of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Company.

On the field trip it was found that Grand and Halton Streets do not exist in this area, even on paper; Seabury and Chambers Streets are occupied by a junk yard dealer.

Dear Sir:

All four streets are platted streets and there
is no record of an official abandonment of any of the
streets.

However, Grand Street is occupied by a house
and a three car garage and the other three streets are
fenced off at Huntington Avenue.

There is a water line in Halton Street and two
sewers in Chambers Street, which extend from Huntington
Avenue to Burrington Street.

Although these streets have no value as public
highways, we object to the abandonment of Chambers
Street, because of the sewers located therein. Since
all the proposed abandonments are necessary to the
making of one large tract, we are of the opinion that
the petitions should be denied.
