AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SMOKING IN THE ARENA PORTION OF THE PROVIDENCE CIVIC CENTER AND THE POSSESSION AND USE OF DRUGS IN THE PROVIDENCE CIVIC CENTER.

Approved September 9, 1974

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Smoking shall be prohibited in the arena portion of the Providence Civic Center and the possession and use of drugs in any form shall be prohibited in all portions of the Providence Civic Center.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
