AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 23,
ENTITLED: "STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES",
SECTION 24 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES.

Approved April 20, 1993

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 23, Section 24 of the Code of Ordinances is repealed.

SECTION 2. No person shall in any manner obstruct the public right-of-way, except for legally parked or standing motor vehicles or upon the filing of a petition and a finding by the Director that the proposed obstruction does not unduly hinder the free-flow of pedestrian and vehicular traffic. The Director is authorized to promulgate regulations to effect the intent hereof.

SECTION 3. Severability - If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof to any person or circumstances, is held unconstitutional, illegal, or otherwise invalid, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance and the application of such provisions to other than those to which it has been invalid, shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

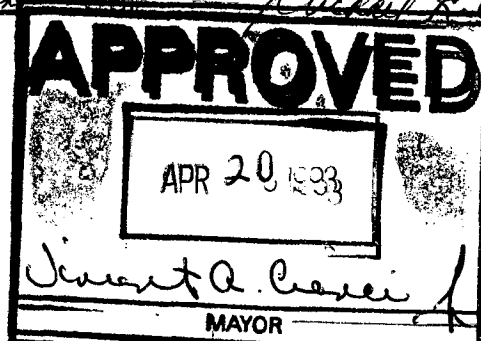
