

In Re: Atwells Avenue street lighting, namely City Council Resolutions #71-72.


During the energy crisis of 1974, all but necessary lighting was stopped, but now the Narragansett Electric Company informs me they shall resume the completion of our Master Plan as soon as possible.

This plan, of course, included the complete relighting of Atwells Avenue which even included the installation of a few additional lights where we thought required them.

Therefore, in the interim I am instructing the Narragansett Electric Company to replace the old mercury vapor light on, Pole #17 Atwells Avenue with a new 21000 lumen fixture, right now.

This location is on the opposite side of the street to #237-239 on your Council Petition #71.


Please accept this letter as authorization to install and replace street lights at the following locations in the City of Providence.
