**SUBJECT:** Request to cause Traffic to become Two-Way along Fern Street

This office has no objections to causing Fern Street to be two-way traffic. According to the City of Providence Code of Ordinances, Article IX, Sec. 2-156, "...all regulations relative to the establishment of one-way streets shall first be approved by resolution of the City Council..." That being said, the presumption is a resolution is required is required to change Fern Street from one-way to two-way.

Due to the present width of Fern Street, allowing two-way traffic will require posting of NO PARKING along one side of the roadway, preferably the east side.
