



At a meeting of the Zoning Board of Review held on Tuesday, May 15, 1956, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Viti Brothers, Inc. owners of Lot 486 on Assessor's Plat 33 on the northwesterly corner of Croom and Grove Streets (177 Croom Street) in an Industrial M-1 Zone, on March 13, 1956, filed an application for permission to install a 20,000 gallon underground fuel oil tank in addition to four existing fuel tanks having a capacity of 22,000 gallons, making a total storage capacity of 42,000 gallons, on the lot described above, and

WHEREAS, A public hearing was held on this application by the Zoning Board of Review at its meeting held on Tuesday, May 15, 1956, after public notice as provided by the Zoning Ordinance,

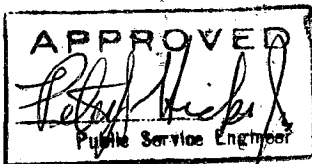
